Wherever there is injustice we will have the courage to speak LOUDLY and STRONGLY for the voiceless in our midst.

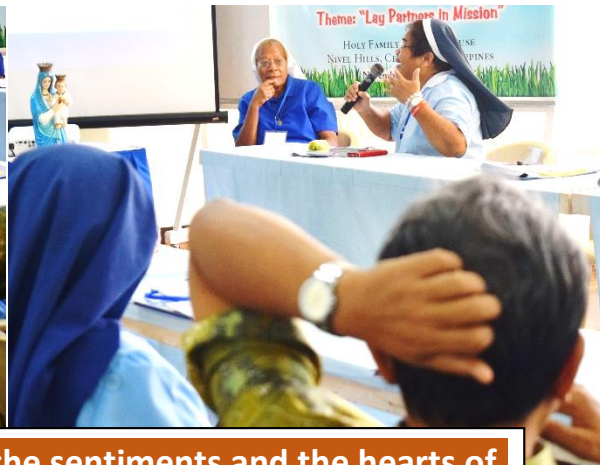

Deep silence hovered the hall as the statement was read by Sr. Philippa

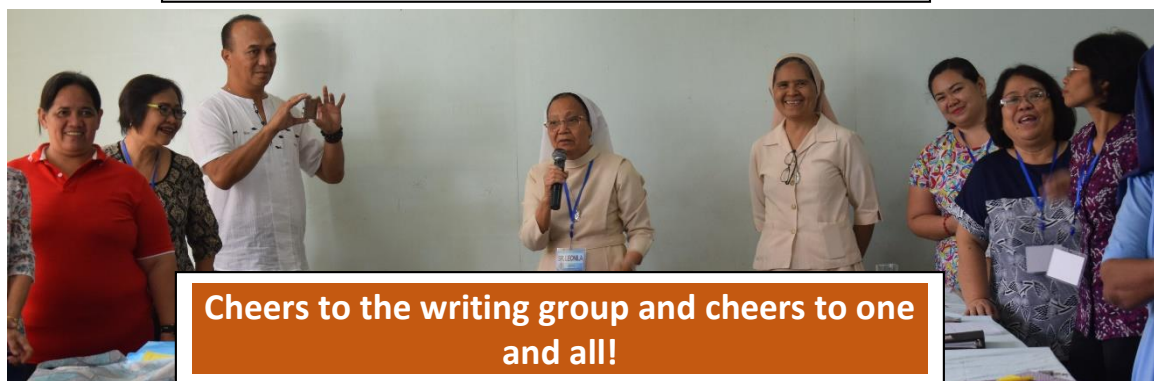




The statement captured the sentiments and the hearts of each one in the room! Everyone moved by the spirit!

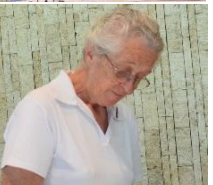

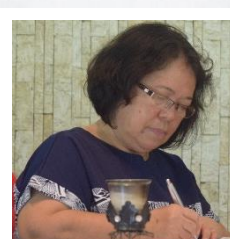
